Completed in 1931, Carew Tower is one of the finest examples of skyscraper modernism in America. At a height of 574 SF, the tower is one of the tallest pre-World War II buildings and reigns as the tallest in Cincinnati. Visitors can stand on the 49th floor observation deck and enjoy one of the city's most spectacular views.

With 1.383 million SF of total floor area, Carew Tower accommodates office space, hotel rooms, and several upscale restaurant, entertainment, and shopping venues such as Hunt Club Clothiers, Havana Martini Club, and in Spring 2007 Boi Na Braza and others. The tower complex includes the Hilton Cincinnati Netherland Plaza Hotel, an example of European-Deco design with decorative work created in France. The complex was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1982 and later designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1994.
