Children's Waterwall

The Children's Waterwall is the highlight of the new Children's Area on Fountain Square. Featuring a series of water jets bursting from the ground and a sheet of water sliding down the wall, the new water feature provides entertainment for children of all ages. The design of the waterwall is not only visually appealing but interactive as well. Children are able to touch the water as it drapes over the wall and play among the water jets as they spill into the air.

In addition, the wall features the last line of a 1854 poem by Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, titled "Catawba Wine". The poem was written to commemorate Cincinnati's vineyards, particularly those of Nicholas Longworth. The wall features the line which reads:

"And this Song of the Vine, This greeting of mine, The winds and the birds shall deliver To the Queen of the West, In her garlands dressed, On the banks of the Beautiful River."
