Description: 3CDC and Black Art Speak are looking for qualified artists to contribute to the Ziegler Park expansion. This project will be informed by and created in partnership with the community surrounding Ziegler Park. This RFQ process seeks to determine qualified artists to create the following assets:

- Interactive light projections
- Murals/ selfie moment murals- Created in partnership with 3CDC summer camp youth
- Light Sculpture
- Alternative proposals- could include furniture or other types of art installations.

Qualifications:

- Professional artists and/ or teams of artists with experience designing site-specific public art commissions are eligible, or those who can demonstrate equivalent skills and experience.
- Experience working with the community in creating public art
- Experience with engaging in community collaboration during and/or after art installation
- Art submissions should consider the history and stories of the community.
- Artists of color living in the Greater Cincinnati/ Tri-state region are encouraged to participate in the RFQ process.

Selection Criteria:

Demonstrates prior experience with:

- Designing large-scale, site-specific, permanent public artwork
- Incorporating community and committee feedback on design development

- Demonstrated use of conducted research to inform design decisions
- Collaborations with partners, design teams, and communities
- Quality of work samples
- Artistic aesthetic

Key Design Elements to Consider

- Selfie moments murals
- Sculptures Art
- Mural Art
- Abstracted art or murals
- Art incorporating light
- Co-created with Community members
