
Budget Range: Not to exceed \$5,000

Description: 3CDC and Black Art Speak are looking for artists to contribute to the Ziegler Park expansion. This project will be informed by and created in partnership with the community surrounding Ziegler Park. This call to artists is looking for the following design elements to be included in the park's expansion:

- Seating art design/ Seating Murals
- Replaceable Reproduction Art
- Interactive Ground murals
- Alternative proposals within budget

Qualifications/ Selection Criteria:

- Artists and/ or teams of artists with experience designing site-specific public art
- Experience working with the community in creating public art
- Experience with engaging in community collaboration during and/or after art installation
- Art submissions should consider the stories and history of the community surrounding Ziegler Park.
- Artists of color living in the Greater Cincinnati/ Tri-state region are encouraged to participate in this call to artist.

 - Note: Participation in this project will not constitute automatic membership in Black Art Speaks.

- **Artist CV/ Resume,**
 - Including previous public art commissions
 - Website (or links to relevant work)
 - Exhibitions, awards, grants
 - Education
 - References (must include (3) art or design professionals who have detailed knowledge of the artist's work and working methods, including fulfilling deadlines, working with the community, etc. Include the contact name, organization, address, telephone, and email for each reference

- **Previous Artwork Images**
 - Submit 3-5 relevant images of completed artworks and/or commissions from the last 10 years.
 - Include a reference sheet detailing information about each chosen piece, including but not limited to Title, Date, Location, Media/Material, Budget, etc.

- **Proposed Concept Images and Details**
 - Artist may submit up to three images for consideration
 - Include a brief 300-word explanation as to how this art represents the community for each image submitted
 - Provide a brief 300-word explanation as to how you will engage the community with your art either during its creation or after its completion during the summer of 2023.
